It is estimated that in Harford County there are more than 250, in Baltimore County there are 8,000 and in Baltimore City there are 3,000 - That is an estimated 12,000 that we know about, many of whom are veterans.

Every day there are groups and ministries that work with and serve the homeless community. We are partnering by collecting goods to be distributed and demonstrate that we care about each individual.

SCB is collecting items for 1000 Bags Of Hope, blankets, hats & gloves and to be distributed. Each item will also have a personal note, as well as a list of ministries and agencies where services can be provided through out the year.

Bag Of Hope: Comb/Brush, Deodorant, Chapstick, Washcloth, Wipes, Toothbrush/Toothpaste, Disposable Razor, Hand Sanitizer, Nail Clippers, Band Aids, Soap, Socks, Hats and Gloves. All items should be unisex and unopened. Items can be regular or travel sized.

Blankets should not be oversized, comforters or bed sets.
We are asking that all items be new and not used or opened.
