Grace Kidz will be having an Easter Egg hunt on Saturday the 23rd at Berthoud High School. This is an amazing opportunity for us to "show up". This will be the fourth year that this event has been held and last year there were over 1200 people who attended. As you can imagine it takes a lot of effort. There will be over 20,000 eggs separated by age group for the kids to collect. All of those eggs need to be stuffed prior to the event, stored until the day of the event, transported to the event, and then distributed. There are carnival booths that need to be created, set up, taken down and manned. There is a need for greeters, set up crews, a security team, food team, sound and tech team, clean-up crew and much more. Grace Place is in need of additional volunteers for our Easter services, and they would like to draw from the Waterboyz for assistance. What they need are "walkers" to be available to walk guest parents and/or children to Kidz Place during all 4 Easter services; Thursday and Sunday. We need 2-3 walkers for Thursday night and 5-6 for each service on Sunday.

Guest children check-in will be at the office on Sunday. We'd like at least 3 to 4 walkers at that station. On Thursday walkers would be stationed in both lobbies available to give instruction and "walk" parents/children to the respective places.

- Ages 0-5 go upstairs for check-in
- K-5 to Kidz Place (on Sunday Kidz Place ages can check in at office or Kidz Place)

Requirements:

- Walkers need to be in place 15 minutes prior to each service and 10 minutes after service begins.
 - They need to be friendly and welcoming.
 - Wear appropriate dress
 - Wear identification tag provided
